ORDER FOR THE REQUIREMENT FOR ALL PERSONS
TO WEAR MASKS IN COURTROOMS

On August 6, 2021, this Court entered an Order reinstating the requirements for all persons to wear masks in the courtrooms in the Lookout Mountain Judicial Circuit. At this time the surge of COVID-19 infections due to the rapid spread of the Delta variant continues. The Center for Disease Control (CDC) has issued guidance for both vaccinated and unvaccinated people to wear masks indoors.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED, effective immediately, that all persons including members of the public, court staff, jurors, and attorneys shall wear appropriate masks while in Superior Court courtrooms, jury assembly areas, jury rooms, law libraries, and all areas immediately adjacent thereto for thirty days from the date of this order, or until further order of the court.
